

ArcGIS Enterprise Setup

In order to access ArcGIS Enterprise you will need to configure your portal to accept BirdOne Fly. To do so, log into ArcGIS Enterprise Portal as an administer and follow the following steps.

1. Go to Content and select "Add Item"




2. Next select Add an application. Be sure to select "Application" as the Type and give it a title. The title can be anything you want. You will also have to give it a tag.



3. Once your application is created you will need to go to the settings for that app. At the very bottom you will see a section called Application. Select Registered Info



- 4. Under Registered Info you will see an App ID: This value is your Client ID for BirdOne to access your portal using Oauth. You will need to enter this value in BirdOne under the ClientID
- 5. Next you will need to add the redirect for BirdOne. To do so, select update under App Registratoin. This will bring up the registered info dialog. In the Redirect URI box, type: robinar://auth and hit add. Be sure to leave the oauth URI that was already there.



6. Once these steps are complete on the portal, log into your enterprise portal. Be sure to exclude /home from your portal URL. The first time you log in, you will be prompted to enter your App ID. Enter the app id from the portal. This information will then be stored for your organization for all other users. After this setup is complete, you will only have to enter your username and login for the portal just as you would other ESRI mobile apps.
